
The State Opioid Response (SOR) grant sponsors free child care, after confirmed eligibility, through CCR&Rs to legal guardians in treatment or recovery services for substance use disorder. Legal guardians need to provide:

- <u>Adult's Identification</u> driver's license or state issued ID
- <u>Residency</u> driver's license or utility bill
- <u>Child's US Citizenship</u> birth certificate and/or citizenship documents
- <u>Concise Student Schedule</u> print out of days and times attending classes
- <u>Qualifying Activity</u> SOR referral form completed by a SUD provider
